52. Lost Coin Community

Cooking for the homeless - their Sunday food provision is cancelled for the foreseeable future.

53. Halifax Street Angels

Due to the Governments advice that we reduce all non-essential contact due to Coronavirus, the decision has been made by our Board of Trustees to suspend our work on Friday and Saturday evenings until further notice.

Having to postpone our new self-employment programme Do Your Own Thing. We have also had to cancel our series of workshops for leaders in partnership with Bright Bird Coaching & Training and Stone King Solicitors.

#### 55. Age Concern Todmorden

#### 57. Victim Support

VS are all working from home now, and only doing phone support, but business as normal.

#### 58. PAWS Pennine Animal Welfare Society

Struggling and trying to formulate a plan to get the animals in the shelter fed, exercised and homed, as well as prepare for a possible influx of abandoned pets as people struggle to feed them. They had a meeting and I am waiting to hear about their decisions.

#### 59. Noah's Ark Money Advice Service

Face to face money advice service suspended - instead we will be offering telephone based support with a view that we'll support clients on a face to face basis as soon as we are able.
